SPTI Programme

The programme consists of 15 training days over 5 weekends. Upon successful completion of the programme, students will be awarded the SPTI Diploma in Clinical Supervision (taught at academic level 7).

Who is this programme suitable for?

This programme is suitable for:

- Those wishing to expand their current skills and knowledge in working with people in a supervisory capacity
- Those wishing to incorporate new knowledge and skills, or
- To expand their current work role, or
- Those wishing to introduce or to enhance supervision within private practice.

The course is based on both relational and a developmental approach and includes:

- The learning styles of supervisees
- Styles of interventions – which styles map to individual supervisees
- Parallel process in supervision
 - including transference, counter-transference and projective identification
- Advanced ethical issues

Entrance Requirements

A qualification at an equivalent level to either UKCP Registered Psychotherapist or BACP Accredited Counsellor, plus two years of post-qualification experience are usually necessary. Applicants who have not already achieved UKCP Registration / BACP accreditation must be able to demonstrate they are actively pursuing this prior to course commencement.

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What will I study?

Module	Title	Content
1	Contracting, purpose and functions of Supervision.	What is supervision? Understanding the purpose, roles and functions of supervision and of the supervisor. Establishing and developing the working alliance. Macro and Micro contracting. Developing a personal philosophy for supervision.
2	Developmental models, learning styles and supervisory responses.	Personal and professional development of the supervisee, learning styles and interventions. Functions and modes of supervision.
3	A relational and developmental route to supervision. Working with unconscious processes.	Human development and its relationship to supervisee development. Transference, counter-transference, projective identification and parallel processes.
4	Ethics.	Course academic requirement. Legal responsibilities, multi-media and technology. Multi-cultural issues, anti-oppressive practice. Interpersonal process recall (IPR).
5	Ethical decision making. Endings.	Ethical decision-making models. Planned and unplanned endings, supervisory responses and responsibilities.

Delivery Method

The programme is delivered in five 3-day modules (Friday - Sunday).

Clinical Requirements

Diploma Students are required to **receive**:

- a minimum of **25 hours**' supervision of their work as a supervisor, from an accredited Supervisor

Diploma Students are required to **provide**:

- a minimum of **50 hours**' supervision of supervisees.

These two criteria must be completed prior to submission of the written component for the required completion of the training.

Assessment

- **Component 1:** Theoretical Competency
- **Component 2:** Clinical Competency
